PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the City Commission is required by City Charter, Article IV, Elections, Section 24, to call by Proclamation any General, Special Election or questions to be decided; and

WHEREAS, a SPECIAL ELECTION is scheduled for Tuesday, November 8, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the following seven (7) City Charter Amendment questions are to be decided upon:

1. Shall the City Charter be amended to provide a 4 year staggered term for Commissioners?

_____ Yes. In favor of amending the charter to provide 4 year staggered terms for all Commissioners.

_____ No. Against 4 year staggered terms and keeping two year non-staggered terms for all Commissioners.

2. Shall the City Charter be amended to provide a 4 year term of office for the Mayor?

_____ Yes. In favor of amending the charter to provide a 4 year term for the office of Mayor.

_____ No. Against 4 year term of office for the Mayor and retaining a 2 year term.

3. Shall the City Charter be amended to eliminate the 2 consecutive term limit on the office of Mayor?

_____ Yes. In favor of eliminating the term limit on the office of Mayor.

_____ No. Against eliminating the term limit on the office of Mayor and retaining the current 2 consecutive term limit.

4. Shall the City Charter be amended to eliminate the requirement for a special election to fill a vacancy on the Commission?

_____ Yes. In favor of deleting the requirement for a special election and allowing the Commission to appoint a temporary replacement to serve until next regularly scheduled election.

_____ No. Against the amendment to the City Charter thereby requiring a special election to fill a vacancy if there is more than one year until the next regularly scheduled election.

5. Should the City Charter be amended to require a 4/5ths vote of the City Commission to terminate the City Manager?

_____ Yes. In favor of amending the Charter to require a 4/5ths vote of the City Commission to terminate the City Manager.

_____ No. Against amending the City Charter thereby requiring only a 3/5ths vote of the City Commission to terminate the City Manager.

6. Should the City Charter be amended to eliminate the provision that allows alcoholic beverages to be sold between 7:00 AM and 2:00 AM?

_____ Yes. In favor of eliminating the Charter provision regulating the sale of alcoholic beverages thereby allowing the City Commission to set the hours of sale for alcoholic beverages.

_____ No. Against the proposed Charter amendment thereby prohibiting the City Commission from setting the hours of sale for alcoholic beverages.

7. Should the Charter be amended to remove the obligation to add fluoride to the City's water supply system?

_____ Yes. In favor of eliminating the obligation to provide fluoride to the City's water supply system and instead allowing the City Commission to decide whether fluoride should be added.

_____ No. Against the proposed Charter amendment thereby requiring fluoride to be added to the City's water supply system.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Commission of the City of Holly Hill, Florida does hereby proclaim the following:

- 1) A Special Election is scheduled for Tuesday, November 8, 2011.
- 2) The following locations are designated as voting places for the purpose of this election and shall be opened at 7:00 a.m. on the date of said election and shall be kept open until 7:00 p.m. on the same day.
