A message from our Public Works Director/City Engineer:

FDOT contractor will be performing maintenance on the Nova Canal along the west side (south bound lane) of Nova Road within the the City of Holly Hill. The activities will be between 3rd Street to 10th Street. Expect the south bound lane, eastern most lane to be closed intermittently. Please see the flyer received from FDOT this morning.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is restoring the Nova Canal drainage system along Nova Road (S.R. 5A) from 10th Street to 3rd Street and from Orange Avenue to Canal View Boulevard/Herbert Street. Work includes clearing, reshaping, clearing & grubbing, tree and vegetation removal, herbicide application, and hydroseeding slopes in a series of canal segments.

WHAT TO EXPECT

During construction, motorists should expect intermittent daytime and nighttime single lane closures along Nova Road to facilitate restoration operations.
