



GOLF CART REGISTRATION

This package provides the information you will need to register your golf cart for use of designated City streets. The registration package consists of a registration and inspection form and information on the rules and regulations governing the operation of golf carts on public roadways. In order to properly register your golf cart you will need to complete the following steps:

1. Complete the golf cart registration form and sign where indicated.
2. Note that proof of liability and property damage insurance will be required at the time of inspection. Please contact your insurance provider for proper coverage.
3. Call 386-248-9475 to make an appointment for a golf cart inspection.
4. It is important that you understand the rules and regulations governing the operation of golf carts. Information on applicable city ordinances and State Traffic Laws will be provided to you during the golf cart inspection.
5. A \$25.00 registration fee will be required at the time of inspection.
6. When the registration fee is paid, you will be issued a decal to place on your golf cart's windshield to indicate that your cart has been approved for use on City streets.
7. The registration is valid for one (1) year with an annual renewal required each January.

THE CITY RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REVOKE ANY CART REGISTRATION AS DEEMED NECESSARY

GOLF CART RULES AND REGULATIONS

The City of Holly Hill allows the use of golf carts on designated City streets. A listing of streets on which golf carts are prohibited is listed below. The Holly Hill Police Department requests your assistance in making this program a success by operating your golf cart in a safe and courteous manner. Operators of golf carts are required to obey all State traffic laws while operating on designated City streets.

Operators of golf carts must be at least 16 years of age and possess a valid driver's license. Please do not allow unauthorized individuals to operate your golf cart. Please respect other motorists by traveling as far to the right of the roadway as safely possible and always yield to pedestrians, bicyclists, and other motorists as required.

Registration and Inspection

A golf cart is defined under Florida Statute as "A motor vehicle designed and manufactured for operation on a golf course for sporting or recreational purposes." To use a golf cart on City streets, the vehicle must be registered with the City and have specific equipment as outlined in City Ordinance 66-151 (e). There will be a \$25.00 annual registration fee, along with an annual inspection, which must be renewed each January (The registration fee will be prorated). Only properly equipped and inspected golf carts may be operated on designated City streets.

Equipment Requirements

A golf cart must be equipped with efficient brakes, brake lights, emergency brake, reliable steering, safe tires, rearview mirror, two headlights, two tail lights, front and rear turn signals, a horn, a windshield and red reflectorized warning devices in both the front and rear.

Basic Operating Rules

Failure to comply with all State traffic laws and local rules and regulations may result in the issuance of a traffic citation and/or revocation of the golf cart registration.

- Golf cart operators must 16 years of age and have a valid driver's license
- Golf carts must have a valid and current City of Holly Hill registration decal in view
- Golf carts must have both liability and property damage insurance as minimum coverage
- Golf carts may be operated on designated City streets only
- The driver and passengers must be seated at all times when the cart is in motion
- Please understand and follow all manufacturers operating instructions and passenger limits
- Golf cart operators are required to follow all State traffic laws and city ordinances
- When not in use, golf carts must be properly parked in driveway, garage or carport
- Golf carts are strictly prohibited on any State or County roadway
- Driving a golf cart on city streets while intoxicated will result in your arrest

Prohibited Streets and Roads

Golf carts may cross Ridgewood Avenue (US-1) at a traffic signal controlled intersection only.

Golf carts may cross LPGA Boulevard at Center Street only.

Golf carts may not be operated on the following roads at any time:

- Nova Road
- LPGA Boulevard
- Ridgewood Avenue (US-1)
- Mason Avenue
- State Avenue
- Carswell Avenue

Golf carts should not be operated on sidewalks or walking trails and may not be driven outside designated parking areas in public parks and recreation areas.

Never operate a golf cart on private property without the owner's permission.

Parking regulations apply to golf carts. Never park in a handicapped parking space unless you have a valid State issued parking authorization.

Hours of Operation

A golf cart may be operated at any time between sunrise and 9:00pm (or during Daylight Savings Time until 10:00pm) on those public areas, parks, and streets that are permitted and authorized provided the golf cart is properly equipped.

Golf Cart Safety Fundamentals

1. Never drive recklessly. Drive courteously and obey all traffic laws.
2. Never drive intoxicated or under the influence of any drug – You will be arrested!
3. Be safe and attentive -- avoid cell phone use, texting, or reading while driving.
4. Golf carts must be equipped with safe tires and a reliable steering system – always keep your cart properly maintained according to the manufacturer's specifications.
5. Only carry the number of passengers for which there are seats.
6. Do not allow anyone to ride standing in the vehicle or on the back platform of the vehicle.
7. Operate the vehicle from the driver's side only.
8. Due to the small size and limited visibility of the turn signals on a golf cart, always use hand signals as well. Signal your intentions well in advance of a turn or maneuver.
9. Check blind spots before turning or backing.
10. Avoid sharp turns at maximum speed, and drive straight up and down slopes to reduce the risk of passenger ejections and rollover. Avoid excessive speed, sudden starts, stops and fast turns.
