Overview

Holly Hill Fire Rescue is a paid professional fire department comprised of a full time staff of thirteen personnel. Under the Fire Chief there are three Lieutenants, three Engineers and six Firefighters.

The department operates out of a single station located at 1020 Daytona Avenue. Fire apparatus includes a 2023 E-One Typhoon pumper.

Holly Hill Fire Rescue provides primary fire and emergency medical services to the City's 12,600 residents. Automatic and



Mutual Aid are also provided to our neighboring agencies; all total more than 3,000 calls annually.

Emergency Medical Operations

Holly Hill Fire Rescue provides Advanced Life Support [ALS] [Non-transport] which is the highest level of pre-hospital emergency medical care. There are 7 paramedics on staff.
