

# HOUSEHOLD SOLID WASTE COLLECTION INFO & TIPS

## RESIDENTIAL GARBAGE COLLECTION:

*The City of Holly Hill City Code of Ordinances Chapter 50 states:*

- All garbage must be bagged in plastic bags prior to placing into your 96-gallon cart that is provided to you by the City of Holly Hill.
- Your garbage cart should be placed curbside with the front of the cart facing the street and the wheels facing your home. This will ensure for proper collection by the collection vehicle.
- DO NOT place yard waste or bulk items such as, construction debris, furniture or appliances in your cart for collection. Waste Management has been instructed to tag the cart with reason(s) why it was not collected. They then notify the City of the incident with the location address and reason(s) the waste was not collected.
- Place your cart curbside for collection the evening prior to your collection day, and no later than 7:00 A.M. the day of your collection.
- Garbage is collected weekly on **Monday and Thursday** for houses east of the railroad tracks to Riverside Drive.
- Garbage is collected weekly on **Tuesday and Friday** for houses west of the railroad tracks.

## SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING



The City of Holly Hill has curbside Single Stream Recycling collection service. All your recyclables can be placed in the same bin. No separating necessary! Overflow recycling can be placed in a paper bag or box next to your bin.

7:00 A.M. Wednesday morning.**

**Plastics:** Bottles and container Number 1 – 7. NO plastic bags, bulky rigid plastics such as buckets, flower pots (no soil) and laundry baskets are accepted curbside.

**Paper:** Newspaper, magazines, catalogs, mixed office paper, junk mail, envelopes, with or without windows telephone books, file folders, paperback books and paper bags. Items must NOT be contaminated by food.

**Food & Beverage Cartons:** All juice boxes, milk and juice containers, soup and broth containers. No juice pouches or straws. All containers must be empty.

**Food & Beverage Containers:** All aluminum and steel cans, empty aerosol cans, clean foil and aluminum pie plates and trays. Please empty and lightly rinse.

Aluminum tabs and steel tabs are acceptable. Remove caps from jars.  
**Cardboard & Paperboard:** All corrugated cardboard boxes, paperboard food boxes including clean pizza boxes, chipboard and paper towel/toilet rolls. Flatten all boxes in the recycling container.

**Glass Bottles & Jars:** Please empty, lightly rinse and include metal caps separately in the recycling container.

**Scrap metal:** All scrap metal items that fit in the recycling container are acceptable.

## YARD WASTE COLLECTION

-----  
*The City of Holly Hill City Code  
of Ordinances Chapter 50 states:*

- All yard waste must be in lengths not to exceed 5 feet, each piece must be 6 inches in diameter or less and the weight of each piece must not exceed 50 pounds.
- Yard waste must be placed at the curb or within 5 feet of the edge of the roadway for collection.
- DO NOT place yard waste in the garbage cart provided by the City.
- Place yard waste curbside the afternoon/evening prior to your collection day, and no later than 7:00 A.M. the day of collection. *Yard waste setout prior to this time will result in a citation for a violation of the City Code of Ordinances.*
- Yard Waste is collected weekly on **Monday** for houses east of the railroad tracks to Riverside Drive.
- Yard Waste is collected weekly on **Tuesday** for houses west of the railroad tracks.
- The City of Holly Hill Code of Ordinances requires all landscapers and yard maintenance companies to haul off and dispose of all yard waste generated by them.

## BULK WASTE COLLECTION

*The City of Holly Hill City Code  
of Ordinances Chapter 50 states:*

- Place all bulk waste items within 5 feet of the curb or edge of the roadway for collection.
- Bulk waste includes discarded furniture (couches, recliners, tables), large appliances (refrigerators, ovens, tv's), plumbing fixtures (bathtubs, toilets, sinks) and used automobile car tires.
- Branches, brush, logs and other green waste are also categorized as bulky waste, although they may be collected separately for shredding and/or composting.
- Place bulk items curbside after noon/evening prior to your collection day, and no later than 7:00 A.M. the day of collection. *Bulk items placed out earlier than these times will result in a citation for a violation of the City Code of Ordinances.*
- Bulk Waste is collected weekly on **Thursday** for houses east of the railroad tracks to Riverside Drive.
- Bulk Waste is collected weekly on **Friday** for houses west of the railroad tracks.

## YARD WASTE DO'S AND DON'TS



**HOLIDAY COLLECTION SCHEDULE 2016** : There will be no collection on the following holidays:  
**New Year's Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas.**

Make-up collections will occur on your next scheduled collection day. Yard waste and recycle items will also be collected on your next scheduled collection day.
